



## DOMAINE GÉRARD FIOU POUILLY FUMÉ 2015



Facing its illustrious rival of Sancerre on the opposite bank of the Loire River, Pouilly-Fumé owes its name to Pouilly-sur-Loire larger village among the 7 that compose the appellation.

With 3,000 acres of Sauvignon Blanc, locally called *Blanc Fumé*, for the grey, smoked-colored bloom that cover its skins, the vineyard represents half the size of its illustrious neighbor of Sancerre.

Here the south-west facing slopes overlooking the Loire are richer in clay with a diverse limestone subsoil. This particular soil gives a smokier minerality and a larger texture to the wines. At Fiou estate this Pouilly Fumé is representing a very characteristic difference from the flint of Sancerre to the Kimeridgian of Menetou Salon offering them the luxury to display all the faces that Loire Sauvignon blanc can offer.

This tiny plot of 4 acres located in the *lieu-dit* "Les Loges" on a rich calcareous slop is one of the closest parcel to the Loire river offering the ideal conditions to express the precision of Pouilly Fumé exciting Terroir.

SOIL TYPE \_\_\_\_\_

Single plot of 4 acres in the lieu-dit "Les Loges". South-west facing hillside. Clay and Portlandian limestone.

VARIETAL \_\_\_\_\_

100 % Sauvignon Blanc. 45 Years old vines.

CULTURE \_\_\_\_\_

After years of organic farming, Gerard decided to start the conversion of the entire domain to organic certification in 2010. Working of the soil to push the roots deeper. Green harvest and manual leaf thinning. Hand-harvesting. Sorting tables are used before a gentle pneumatic pressing. Settlement of 24 hours at cold temperature to clarify the wine.

VINIFICATION \_\_\_\_\_

Fermentation happens in thermoregulated stainless steel tanks followed by a maturation of 5 months on fine lees with "Bâtonnage" (racking) each week to keep the lees in contact with the wine.

TASTING NOTES \_\_\_\_\_

Elegant texture and fleshy mouthfeel. Slightly spicy and smoky aroma of nectarines and tropical fruits. Admirable combination of density and vivacity. Refine notes of honeysuckle linger at the finish.
