



**MOULIN DE GASSAC "ANIANE"**  
**GUILHEM ROSÉ - PAYS D'HÉRAULT IGP**  
**2016**



Moulin de Gassac, or windmill of Gassac river, is the entry line of the iconic estate Mas de Daumas Gassac. Considered by many as the greatest estate of the Languedoc region, "A Lafite in the Languedoc", they also act responsible by willing to preserve the heritage of the region. Made of carefully selected grapes bought to local farmers, this line made of a white, a red and a Rosé showcase what this region is capable of when speaking of easy drinking and affordable wine. "Guilhem", gaelic version of William, is a tribute to a local monastery based at Saint-Guilhem-le-desert whose monks launched the wine production in the region some centuries ago.

**SOIL TYPE** \_\_\_\_\_

Clay and limestone plateau with quartz and gravels.  
 Located on the Thau lagoon area.

**VARIETAL** \_\_\_\_\_

50 % Syrah – 50% Carignan  
 Low yields 50 hl/ha

**VINIFICATION** \_\_\_\_\_

100% destemmed. Direct pressing Rosé with juice selection.  
 Must clarification at low temperature.  
 Fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks during 5 months.

**TASTING NOTES** \_\_\_\_\_

Vivid salmon color with a fine nose of crushed red flowers, cherry and redcurrant. The light, refreshing palate is cooling, with lovely red apple skin and peach notes. Fruity but dry, with a crisp, lip-smacking finish. 12% alc by vol.
