



CHÂTEAU L'OMBRIÈRE BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR 2014



Own by the Latorse family, also owner of Château Gabaron in the neighbor "Entre Deux Mers", the Château l'Ombrière is located in the *Premières Côtes de Bordeaux* which owe their name to their location on the hills overlooking the Garonne's flowing water.

Following the winding path of the river during 38 miles long, the thin strip of land of the "Premieres Côtes" is never more than five kilometers wide and offers a varied landscape of hills and valley. The vineyards' location ensures that they receive plenty of sunshine. Pebbles and steep slopes provide natural drainage and a choice of soils: Gravelly-cobble, clay-chalk, and clay-gravel on the top of the hills.

SOIL TYPE

Located at St Caprais de Bordeaux, Château l'Ombrière stand on the best Terroir of the "1eres Côtes de Bordeaux" – Clay and Limestone soils – South oriented hillsides overlooking the Garonne River.

VARIETAL

70 % Cabernet Sauvignon 30 % Merlot / 49 Years old vines
Yields 40 hl/Hectares

CULTURE

Hand harvesting. Multiple sorting tables are used in order to bring the cleanest raw material possible into the tanks.

VINIFICATION

Cold prefermentary maceration of 3 to 4 days to promote the fruity flavors and soft tannins. Pump over and punching of the cap are used to extend the body with no oak used in the assemblage.
18 months ageing in French oak barrels (55%) and the rest in stainless steel Tanks.

TASTING NOTES

A lot of ripe black fruit nicely balance by sophisticated tannins. An affordable taste of the left bank style.
