Founded in 1800



## Morgon *Beaujolais Cru since 1946* - Vignes de 1935 -

### Origin

Another single vineyard from Jean-Michel DUPRE, this one planted in 1935 in the climat "Grands Cras" in Morgon covered by compacted volcanic ash called "tuff".

### From the vines...

**Varietal** : 100% Gamay Noir.

**Vineyard area** : 6,25 acres.

**Density of plantation** : 4000 vines per acre.

**Vine Age** : 82 years old.

**Plot** : « Grands Cras ».

**Soil type** : tuff: compacted volcanic ash and silt.

**Elevation** : 320m.

**Exposure** : East.

**Farming** : Sustainable farming, short pruning in bushes, putting straw in the vines.

**Winemaking** : 9 days maceration with whole clusters in gridded vats.

**Aging** : Aged for 9 months in concrete vats.

**Clarification** : Light filtration.

### ... To the glass

Red garnet robe with purple tints. A nose displaying cherry, liquorice and peonies notes. The mouth is full and rich with savory and fruity notes. A finish marked with stone fruits, peppery notes and minerality on the backbone!

### Food pairings

Try it with burger, steaks, pork ribs or cheese.
