



**DOMAINE GALEVAN, CORALIE GOUMARRE**  
*"LEON & LILI" IGP MEDITERRANEE 2023*



9<sup>th</sup> generation Coralie Goumarre is at the helm of the family winery since 1995. Located in the renown village of Courthézon, neighbor with Château Beaucastel, Coralie's 49 hectares are planted with vines of 60 years-old in average, the oldest being over 100 years-old. Certified organic since 2011 she uses native yeast and vinification are made with no addition of SO2 to preserve the essence of the wine in the most natural way.

Covering a large area on the southeast coast of France, roughly corresponding to the Provence wine region and the southern Rhône, this IGP shares its land with multiple AOP appellations like Châteauneuf du Pape, Bandol or Côtes de Provence. The Terroir here is varied but is broadly characterized by both the very southern edges of the Alps, and the warm, dry Mediterranean climate.

This IGP provides a great alternative from the stringent winemaking requirements and grape variety selections imposed by the area's AOC laws. "Léon & Lili" are the two winery's dog that follows Coralie everywhere she goes; only difference, they are not pink and a little less funny looking...

SOIL TYPE \_\_\_\_\_

Stony and sandy river hillsides.

VARIETAL \_\_\_\_\_

Grenache Noir (60%), Clairette (20%), Merlot (10%), Cab. Sauvignon (10%)

CULTURE \_\_\_\_\_

Low yielding to ensure an optimum maturity. Harvest is made by hand in early morning to keep the freshness of the fruit and slowly extract the aromas. Accurate selection on sorting tables. **Organic certified since 2011.**

VINIFICATION \_\_\_\_\_

Direct pressing in pneumatic press at low pressure. Co-Fermentation of all the grapes with native yeasts in stainless-steel tanks. Few months ageing on fine lees in stainless. Bottling in the spring after light filtration. SO2 added at the bottling.

TASTING NOTES \_\_\_\_\_

This dry Rosé is showing a light rose petal robe. Flavor of crushed strawberry and sour cherry dominates. The mid-pallet is ample and soft. It finishes with a lot of thirst-quenching character.
