

DOMAINE GALEVAN, CORALIE GOUMARRE


CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE BLANC 2021





9th generation Coralie Goumarre is at the helm of the family winery since 1995.
Located in the renown village of Courthézon, neighbor with Château Beaucastel,
Coralie's 49 hectares are planted with vines of 60 years-old in average, the oldest
being over 100 years-old. Certified organic since 2011 she uses native yeast and
vinification are made with no addition of SO2 to preserve the essence of the
wine. Coralie is proud to be a "Natural" winemaker delivering life in her wines.
Located on the alluvial terrace of the Rhône, her estate is made of large single
blocks mostly based on the impressive Terroir "Galets roulés", or rounded
pebbles made of pure silica, on a base of iron oxide rich clay. This Terroir found
only in Chateauneuf is the one who makes their wine inimitable.

In a region of fully textured whites she favor elegantly balanced wines with a
dominance of fruit and floral notes with a fine line of mineral acidity. The oak
fermentation is here to open up the wine and densify the texture but never it
mask the expression of the Terroir by excessive toast.

VINIFICATION -

Alcoholic fermentation with native yeast in two 500l and one 228l new French oak barrels. Ageing on fine lees for 18 months in the same barrels with "bâtonnage", if necessary after tasting the wine during the barrel ageing. Malolactic fermentation is completed.
